



SeniorServ Receives \$20,000 Grant from Bank of America

Grant will support programs from the county's largest nonprofit provider of Meals on Wheels and other senior services.

Anaheim, Calif. (August 31, 2018) – SeniorServ was presented with a \$20,000 grant from Bank of America, as part of its philanthropic partnership with community service providers throughout Orange County.

For more than 50 years, SeniorServ has been the largest nonprofit senior nutrition and supportive service provider in Orange County – annually serving nearly one million meals to over 10,000 at-risk seniors through a continuum of care including: Meals on Wheels and case management services to homebound seniors, daily lunches in 24 senior centers, friendly visitor volunteers, adult day care services, and care coordination.

This grant will help people like SeniorServ Meals on Wheels recipient, Geraldine, whose health challenges prevent her from receiving the nutrition she needs to remain living at home; the place she is inspired to engage in charitable work *herself*. During the years she’s received meals, Geraldine kept her hands busy by making more than 3000 quilts for charity. “I try to pass on good deeds when I can,” she explained.

“When it comes to food insecurity, our aging seniors can be one of the most vulnerable populations, especially in Orange County where the cost of living is high. We’re proud to support SeniorServ in helping seniors meet their basic needs so that they can maintain quality of life as they age.” said Allen Staff, Orange County market president for Bank of America.
